

17.) Section 2 on drawing S01 indicates a foundation for the new 6-5/8' diameter HSS column. We are requesting clarification if this is intended to be a footing, or a spreader pad on top of the existing foundation wall. The engineer must re-submit drawings with clarification of this area.

18.) Drawing S01 states "Provide temporary support to notched logs, see Detail B on Sheet S06. Should this sheet be S07. The engineer must re-submit drawings with clarification of this area.


19.) There is a protective fencing around the building is shown on Sheet S01 of Philips Engineering drawings. The owner is to provide the same fencing which has been on site for the last 8 months or pay the municipality of Arran – Elderslie a fee of \$375.00 per month until all the structural work is finished on the job site.

20.) No occupancy of the building will be granted until all work is finished in phase 2 of construction.

21.) Along the north exterior wall of the west wing, there are signs of settlement (kitchen area). We request that areas will be opened up and inspected by Philips Engineering and they will designate replacement or strengthening of the foundation area. A detailed report on the foundation and details are required by January 31, 2007 from Philips Engineering.

22.) On drawing S07, the typical wall section is provided for the reconstructed west wing of the building. We are requesting that the wall section provide information relating to the flashing, vapour barrier, air space and drywall. A concrete spreader pad is proposed around 3 sides of the new construction as shown in Detail "A". The designer should clarify if the wall below the is solid masonry, or a stud wall to ensure that the loads are properly transmitted from the upper wall to the lower wall. Note: That if it is a stud wall below, the bearing wall above does not appear to line up with the bearing wall. The engineer must re-submit drawings with clarification of this area.
