Yearly Fire Permits can be obtained at the Municipal Office and are free, mandatory and required all year round. By obtaining a fire permit you have simply indicated that you wish to burn. The responsibility for conducting a safe burn is yours.

## **NOTICE TO RESIDENTS: MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM USERS**

As per the Municipal Code the following watering restrictions apply at all times:  
Persons owning or occupying premises bearing an odd municipal street-numbered property may water on odd-numbered calendar days between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and between 7:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m.

Persons owning or occupying premises bearing an even municipal street-numbered property may water on even-numbered calendar days between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and between 7:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m.

We thank you for your on-going compliance with the municipal code and the watering restrictions.
