ATTENTION BURGOYNE WATER USERS

Water Samples collected in Burgoyne by Arran-Elderslie Operators have indicated a presence of Total Coliforms. The Grey Bruce Health Unit is placing a complete "**Boil Water Advisory**" on the Burgoyne Water System. This is an up sizing to the present "Precautionary Boil Water Advisory presently in effect by the Municipality.

Municipal Operators are in the process of shocking the well and distribution system with chlorine. Water in the Burgoyne System will be unavailable for approximately 12 hours during that process. Our hopes are to have the water restored by 9am on Saturday, September 28, 2019 but the boil water advisory will remain in effect. The Municipality asks all Burgoyne Water Users to please flush their household water taps for 5 minutes or until the odour of chlorine has diminished once the water service has been restored.

Burgoyne Water Users have access to treated and tested Municipal Drinking Water at #170 Yonge Street North in Tara. An outdoor water faucet is located on the exterior wall of the pumphouse situated below the Tara Water Tower. Please bring your own containers or vessels to collect the drinking water.
