



Information for Voters

Eligibility

A person is entitled to be an elector at an election held in a local municipality, if on voting day he or she is:

- a Canadian citizen;
- at least 18 years old;
- residing in the local municipality or an owner or tenant there, or the spouse of such owner or tenant; and
- not otherwise prohibited from voting.

Are you recorded as an eligible elector for the upcoming municipal election? Voter Look Up allows electors to confirm whether they are on the Preliminary List of Electors, used to prepare the Voters' List for election day.

Please call to confirm and update your elector details, especially your birth date which will be required when you vote. For more information, please contact the Municipality.
