In accordance with the Integrated Accessibility Standard Regulation the County of Bruce is required to establish, implement, maintain and document a multi-year accessibility plan which outlines the organization's strategy to prevent and remove barriers.

The County is also required to consult with its Accessibility Advisory Committee as well as persons with disabilities to provide the opportunity to participate and provide valuable feedback to maintain an awareness of people's accessibility needs.

The County of Bruce is committed to making accessibility throughout the organization a reality. Our progress so far would not have been possible without the vision of Bruce County Council, Staff and the Accessibility Advisory Committee. There is much more to accomplish and the County will continue to identify and remove barriers in order to create accessible spaces and services that everyone can use.
