PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

TAKE NOTICE that the Municipality of Arran-Elderslie will be holding a public meeting with respect to the proposed continued development of the Arran Landfill Site. The meeting will be held on **Tuesday, September 20th, 2011 at 7 pm, at the Arkwright Hall, 648 Bruce Road 17.**

The Arran Landfill site is located north of Bruce County Road No.17, about 4.5 km southwest of Tara, in the south half of Lot 20, Concession 7, in the former Township of Arran, County of Bruce. The Arran Landfill Site was originally approved by the Ministry of Environment (MOE) in 1972. In order to continue development of the Arran Landfill Site beyond the current 1.73 hectare (ha) footprint but within the overall approved capacity, an application to amend the existing MOE Certificate of Approval has been submitted to the MOE along with a Hydrogeological Study, Environmental Impact Study, Stormwater Design Report, and Plan of Development and Operations. Information regarding the proposed development will be provided at the meeting.

ANY persons may attend the meeting and/or make written or verbal representation either in support of or in opposition of the proposed development.
